- 14 this section, no person shall operate a passenger vehicle
- 15 in this state unless each child who is a passenger in that
- 16 vehicle and who is four (4) eight (8) years of age or

under, and who weighs forty (40) eighty (80) pounds or 1 2 less, is properly secured in a child safety restraint 3 system in a seat of the vehicle other than the front seat, 4 except if the vehicle is only equipped with one (1) row of 5 seats, the child may be properly secured in a child safety restraint system in the front passenger seat of the 6 7 vehicle. 8 **Section 2.** W.S. 31-5-1302(a)(ii), (vi) and (vii) is 9 10 repealed. 11 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2003. 12
