A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to child care services; excluding child  
2 care employees paid or subsidized by the department of  
3 family services from coverage under the workers'  
4 compensation program; amending a definition; and providing  
5 for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 27-14-102(a)(vii) by creating a new  
10 subparagraph (Q) is amended to read:

12 **27-14-102. Definitions.**

14 (a) As used in this act:

15

1           (vii) "Employee" means any person engaged in any  
2 extrahazardous employment under any appointment, contract  
3 of hire or apprenticeship, express or implied, oral or  
4 written, and includes legally employed minors and aliens  
5 authorized to work by the United States department of  
6 justice, immigration and naturalization service.  
7 "Employee" does not include:

8  
9           (Q) An individual providing child day care  
10 or babysitting services, whose wages are subsidized or paid  
11 in whole or in part by the Wyoming department of family  
12 services. This exclusion from coverage does not exclude  
13 from coverage an individual providing child day care or  
14 babysitting services as an employee of any individual or  
15 entity other than the Wyoming department of family  
16 services.

18           **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon  
19 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
20 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
21 Constitution.
