(Q) An individual providing child day care 9

or babysitting services, whose wages are subsidized or paid 10

in whole or in part by the Wyoming department of family 11

12 services. This exclusion from coverage does not exclude

13 from coverage an individual providing child day care or

14 babysitting services as an employee of any individual or

entity other than the Wyoming department of family 15

16 services.

18 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon

completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 19
