## for

1 ACT relating to professions and occupations; AN establishing the animal euthanasia certification board as 2 3 specified; authorizing the board to certify animal 4 euthanasia technicians; specifying eligibility criteria; 5 specifying approved training and testing; prohibiting 6 persons from acting as animal euthanasia technicians 7 without certification; granting rulemaking authority; providing definitions; providing penalties; providing for 8 9 an appropriation; and providing for an effective date. 10

16 **33-30-216.** Definitions.

1 2 (a) As used in this act: 3 4 (i) "Board" means the Wyoming animal euthanasia 5 technician certification board; 6 7 (ii) "Certified animal euthanasia technician" means a person who is employed or sponsored by a law 8 9 enforcement agency whose duties include euthanizing 10 unwanted, sick, injured or dangerous animals; 11 12 (iii) "Euthanasia" or "euthanizing" means the 13 act or practice of providing a humane death for animals 14 through the use of euthanizing drugs; 15 (iv) "Euthanizing drugs" means 16 any pentobarbital-based drug labeled by the manufacturer for 17 the purpose of euthanizing animals, with the exception of 18 Schedule I drugs as defined in W.S. 35-7-1013 and 19 20 35-7-1014; 21 22 (v) "This act" means W.S. 33-30-216 through 23 33-30-222. 24

33-30-217. Animal euthanasia technician certification 1 2 board created; composition; terms of office.

3

4 (a) There is created the animal euthanasia technician 5 certification board. The board shall consist of five (5) members appointed by the governor. Initial board members 6 7 shall be appointed upon the recommendation of the Wyoming state board of veterinary medicine. Thereafter, the animal 8 9 euthanasia technician certification board shall make 10 recommendations to the governor after receiving the recommendation of the Wyoming state board of veterinary 11 12 medicine.

13

14 The initial membership of the board shall include (b) at least one (1) licensed veterinarian, one (1) actively 15 employed animal control officer, one (1) law enforcement 16 17 official whose duties include supervision of animal control and one (1) citizen from the public at large. Thereafter, 18 members of the board shall be certified euthanasia 19 20 technicians, veterinarians licensed in this state or 21 certified peace officers.

(c) Members of the board shall serve terms of three 23 24 (3) years. The initial board shall have staggered terms of

1 one (1) member for one (1) year, two (2) members for two 2 (2) years and two (2) members for three (3) years. 3 4 33-30-218. Duties and powers of board. 5 6 (a) The board shall: 7 (i) Grant, suspend or revoke the certification of 8 9 any animal euthanasia technician. The board shall examine 10 the credentials of applicants for certification and current 11 certificate holders and may grant, suspend or revoke 12 certification on the basis of the credentials or upon other 13 cause as specified by the rules of the board. In addition, 14 the board may require oral interviews and practical 15 demonstrations; 16 17 (ii) Examine and approve available animal 18 euthanasia training and testing programs for use by 19 applicants for certification. In the absence of available 20 animal euthanasia training and testing programs, the board 21 shall develop a program for use by animal euthanasia 22 technicians in this state. A program approved or developed pursuant to this paragraph shall include: 23 24

1 (A) Methods of humanely euthanizing 2 injured, sick, homeless or unwanted animals; 3 4 (B) Security precautions; 5 (C) Record keeping; and 6 7 (D) Other skills as determined necessary by 8 9 the board. 10 11 (iii) Promulgate rules and regulations in 12 accordance with the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act 13 necessary for the implementation of this act, including the establishment of fees provided for by this act and rules 14 relating to professional conduct which establish ethical 15 and professional standards of practice; 16 17 (iv) Conduct investigations and hearings pursuant 18 to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act. 19 20 21 33-30-219. (a) Any person applying for a certification as an 1 2 animal euthanasia technician shall be employed or sponsored 3 by a law enforcement agency. An applicant shall make a 4 written application to the board which shall include: 5 6 (i) A fee in the amount established pursuant to 7 rules and regulations not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00); 8 9 10 (ii) Proof that the applicant: 11 12 Is a citizen of the United States or is (A) 13 lawfully admitted to remain and work in the United States; 14 15 (B) Is employed or sponsored by a law 16 enforcement agency; 17 18 (C) Has not been convicted of a felony or any criminal violation relating to cruelty to animals or 19 20 animal neglect; and 21 (D) Has completed an animal euthanasia 22 training and testing program approved or developed by the 23 24 board.

1 2 (iii) Proof that the employing sponsoring agency 3 has obtained any required federal permits; 4 5 (iv) A criminal history background check required pursuant to W.S. 7-19-106(a)(x); 6 7 (v) Any other information required by the board. 8 9 10 (b) A certification issued pursuant to this section 11 shall be for a two (2) year period unless surrendered by 12 the certified animal euthanasia technician or revoked or suspended by the board for cause. The certified animal 13 euthanasia technician shall renew the certificate every two 14 (2) years. Application for renewal shall be accompanied 15 16 by: 17 (i) A fee in the amount established pursuant to 18 rules and regulations not to exceed one hundred dollars 19 20 (\$100.00); 21 (ii) Proof of current employment or sponsorship 22 by a law enforcement agency; and 23 24

1 (iii) Proof of a minimum of eight (8) hours of 2 board approved training during the previous two (2) year 3 period.

4

5 (C) The fees received under subsection (a) or (b) of this section shall be deposited with the state treasurer 6 who shall credit the money to an account within the special 7 revenue fund. All monies credited to the account shall be 8 9 expended only upon appropriation by the legislature to 10 defray costs and expenses incurred in the administration of 11 this act.

12

13 In addition to other requirements of this act, a (d) certified animal euthanasia technician shall register with 14 the Wyoming board of pharmacy to purchase, possess and 15 16 administer euthanizing drugs.

17

(e) If at any time there is a change in employment or 18 sponsorship of a certified animal euthanasia technician by 19 20 a law enforcement agency, the law enforcement agency shall 21 immediately notify the board of the change. The board 22 shall adopt rules relating to changes in employment or sponsorship by law enforcement agencies for the purposes of 23 24 this act. For the purposes of this subsection, "change" or

1 "changes" includes transfer to another division or part of the law enforcement agency as well as firing, termination 2 3 or other release of employment or sponsorship by the law 4 enforcement agency. 5 6 33-30-220. Compensation of board members. 7 8 Board members shall receive no compensation for their 9 services but shall receive per diem and travel expenses in 10 the manner and amount provided for state employees by W.S. 11 9-3-102 and 9-3-103. 12 13 33-30-221. Prohibited acts; penalties. 14 15 Any person employed or sponsored by a law enforcement 16 agency who euthanizes an animal by injection of euthanizing 17 drugs as defined in this act without being certified 18 according to the provisions of this act is quilty of a 19 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more that seven 20 hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), imprisonment for not more 21 than six (6) months, or both. 22

Access to, and dissemination of, 10 information. 11 12 (a) Criminal history record information shall be 13 disseminated by criminal justice agencies in this state, whether directly or through any intermediary, only to: 14 15 (x) The Wyoming animal euthanasia technicians 16 17 board for purposes of obtaining background information on applicants for certification by the board. 18 19 33-30-204. Board of pharmacy designated agency to 6 administer registration. 7 The Wyoming state board of pharmacy in addition to any 8 9 other duties imposed upon it by law is hereby designated as 10 agency to administer the registration of the the 11 manufacture, distribution and dispensing of controlled 12 substances as hereinafter provided in this act. The board 13 shall register certified animal euthanasia technicians as 14 provided by W.S. 33-30-219, for the limited purposes of 15 purchasing, possessing and administering euthanizing drugs

as defined by W.S. 33-30-216(a)(iv), and performing the 16 17 duties and powers of a certified animal euthanasia 18 technician.

20 Section 3. There is appropriated from the budget 21 reserve account ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) to the 22 Wyoming animal euthanasia technician board for the purposes of this act. 23
