7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 37-15-402(a) is amended to read:

11 37-15-402. Cost based pricing.

- 13 (a) Services provided by a telecommunications company
- 14 that provides noncompetitive services shall be priced to
- 15 ensure that the service's revenues from sale of the service
- 16 recover the total service long-run incremental cost of

1 providing that service, except as provided in this section. 2 Total service long-run incremental cost studies used by a 3 telecommunications company shall be filed with the 4 commission every three (3) years unless required by the 5 commission more frequently. All total service long-run incremental cost studies required pursuant to this section 6 7 shall be filed in the form required by commission rule and under protective order as a trade secret and shall be 8 9 subject commission review to and approval. 10 Telecommunications companies having fewer than thousand (30,000) access lines in the state are exempt from 11 12 the requirement to file cost studies every three (3) years, 13 but do remain subject to the commission powers in W.S. 14 37-15-401(a)(iv). A telecommunications company having fewer than thirty thousand (30,000) access lines in the state may 15 utilize a reasonable total service long-run incremental 16 17 cost study surrogate, in lieu of conducting its own study, based on cost studies as are available for comparable, 18 including nonregulated, telecommunications companies in 19 20 this state or other states. The commission shall by rule 21 require the additional submission of total service long-run 22 incremental cost studies for noncompetitive services as 23 follows:

1	(i) The commission shall adopt rules providing
2	for the uniform application of total service long-run
3	incremental cost study methodology for all
4	telecommunications companies subject to the provisions of
5	this section;

7	(ii) The rules shall provide for:
8	
9	(A) The commission review of all total
10	service long-run incremental cost studies approved by the
11	commission prior to January 1, 2005;
12	
13	(B) A new filing for any study not
14	previously meeting the uniform application of total service
15	long-run incremental cost study methodology adopted by
16	commission rule;
17	
18	(C) A timetable for the filings required
19	under subparagraph (B) of this paragraph and for commission
20	review and approval of the filings.
21	
22	Section 2. The public service commission shall
23	provide notice of the proposed adoption of rules pursuant
24	to this act to the joint corporations, elections and

political subdivisions interim committee not later than 1

2 October 1, 2004. Rules adopted by the commission pursuant

to this act shall be effective July 1, 2005. 3

5 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon

completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 6

7 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

Constitution. 8
