AN ACT relating to telecommunications; creating a select 1 legislative committee to study the state telecommunications 2 universal service fund; providing an appropriation; 3 providing for a report; and providing for an effective 4 date. 5 6 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8 9 Section 1. 10 11 (a) There is created a select legislative committee 12 to study the state telecommunications universal service fund created by W.S. 37-15-501. The committee shall consist 13 14 of: 15

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1 (i) Three (3) representatives from the house, with not more than two (2) members from the same political 2 3 party. The members shall be appointed by the speaker of the 4 house, who shall also appoint a cochairman of the 5 committee;

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(ii) Three (3) senators from the senate, with 7 not more than two (2) members from the same political 8 9 party. The members shall be appointed by the president of 10 the senate, who shall also appoint a cochairman of the 11 committee.

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13 (b) The committee shall study the current state telecommunications universal service fund and the effects 14 of changing the current fund from a rate based fund to a 15 16 cost based fund. The public service commission and the 17 office of consumer advocate shall provide information and other support to the committee as requested. 18 The legislative service office shall staff the committee. 19 The 20 committee may retain consultants as necessary and shall 21 report to the joint corporations, elections and political 22 subdivisions interim committee its findings, including any recommendations for statutory changes. The report shall be 23 24 provided not later than September 30, 2004.

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2 (c) There is appropriated from the general fund to the legislative service office one hundred thousand dollars 3 4 (\$100,000.00) or as much thereof as is necessary for 5 purposes of this act. 6 7 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 8 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 9 10 Constitution. 11 12 (END)
