Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:  Section 1. W.S. 35-7-1002(a)(xxiv) is amended to read:
35-7-1002. Definitions.
(a) As used in this act:

(xxiv) "Law enforcement officer" means 1 2 sheriff, undersheriff or sheriff's deputy of any county of 3 this state, any duly authorized municipal policeman of any 4 city or town of this state, any member of the Wyoming 5 highway patrol, any police officer of the University of Wyoming or any Wyoming community college who is a peace 6 7 officer, any superintendent, assistant superintendent or full-time park ranger of a state park or historic site who 8 9 has qualified pursuant to W.S. 9-1-701 through 9-1-707, 10 when acting within the boundaries of the state park or 11 historic site or when responding to a request to assist 12 other law enforcement officers performing their official 13 duties, or any special agent employed by the commissioner 14 under this act; 15 16 This act is effective immediately upon Section 2. 17 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the 18 Constitution. 19 20 21 (END)
