A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to veterans; providing an appropriation for  
 2 the development of a master plan for the Oregon Trail state  
 3 veteran's cemetery; requiring a report; and providing for  
 4 an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8       **Section 1.** There is appropriated from the general  
 9 fund to the adjutant general nineteen thousand four hundred  
 10 fifty dollars (\$19,450.00) for the development of a master  
 11 plan for the Oregon Trail state veteran's cemetery. The  
 12 plan shall be developed in accordance with federal  
 13 requirements to allow for reimbursement of expenditures for  
 14 the development, expansion and operation of the cemetery.  
 15 To the extent reimbursement is available, the adjutant  
 16 general shall apply to appropriate federal agencies for  
 17 reimbursement of expenditures for the development of the

1 master plan. Any reimbursement of expenditures made under  
2 this section shall be deposited with the state treasurer to  
3 be placed in the general fund.

5       **Section 2.** The adjutant general shall report to the  
6 joint transportation and highways interim committee not  
7 later than September 15, 2004, regarding the development of  
8 a master plan for the Oregon Trail state veteran's  
9 cemetery. The report shall include a timeline for future  
10 expansion and development, anticipated costs for each phase  
11 of expansion and development and the available funding  
12 sources for expansion and development.

14       **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon  
15 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
16 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
17 Constitution.
