Civil air patrol.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the civil air patrol; transferring the
2 civil air patrol from the department of transportation to
3 the military department; specifying limitations on
4 expenditures; repealing inconsistent provisions; and
5 providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-15-101 through 19-15-103 are
10 created to read:

15 **19-15-101. Civil air patrol; authorization of**
16 **expenditure of state funds.**

1

2 (a) The department may expend state funds for the
3 purchase of:

4

5 (i) Civil air patrol aviation education training
6 aids;

7

8 (ii) Books and equipment;

9

10 (iii) Maintenance and hangar rents of "on-loan"
11 United States air force aircraft; and

12

13 (iv) Maintenance supplies and equipment for a
14 communications network for the civil air patrol.

15

16 **19-15-102. Approval of purchase order.**

17

18 No expenditure of state funds shall be made unless a
19 purchase order is approved by the department. Funds are
20 under the control of the department.

21

22 **19-15-103. Limitation of expenditures.**

23

1 (a) Under W.S. 19-15-101 through 19-15-103 no
2 expenditure of state funds shall be authorized by the
3 department unless the purchase is specifically for:

4

5 (i) Civil air patrol aviation education training
6 aids, books and equipment;

7

8 (ii) Maintenance and hangar rent of "on-loan"
9 United States air force aircraft of two hundred fifty (250)
10 horsepower or less; and

11

12 (iii) Maintenance supplies and equipment for
13 civil air patrol communications network and administrative
14 costs as may be approved by the department.

15

16 **Section 2.** W.S. 10-3-501 through 10-3-503 are
17 repealed.

18

19 **Section 3.** All supplies and equipment of the civil
20 air patrol owned by the state of Wyoming shall be
21 transferred to the military department.

22

23 **Section 4.** This act is effective immediately upon
24 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

1 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
2 Constitution.
