A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; modifying qualifications
 2 and fees for specified hunting licenses; and providing for
 3 effective dates.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-1-705(e) is amended to read:

8

9 **23-1-705. Complimentary licenses; one-shot antelope**
 10 **hunt licenses; gunpowder and buckskin hunt licenses;**
 11 **gratuitous licenses.**

13 (e) The department shall issue for a fee ~~of two~~
 14 ~~dollars (\$2.00)~~ established by rule of the commission a
 15 resident deer, ~~or~~ antelope or elk license ~~and for a fee of~~
 16 ~~five dollars (\$5.00) an elk license~~ to any resident who ~~was~~
 17 ~~born on or before January 1, 1930~~ is at least seventy (70)

1 years of age prior to the issuance of the license, who has
2 continuously resided in Wyoming for at least the ~~forty (40)~~
3 fifty (50) years immediately preceding application for the
4 license and who is physically able to personally hunt and
5 pursue his own game. The fee established for a license
6 under this subsection shall be not more than sixty-five
7 percent (65%) nor less than sixty percent (60%) of the
8 resident fee specified in W.S. 23-2-101 for the particular
9 species.

10
11 **Section 2.** The game and fish commission may adopt
12 rules and regulations implementing the provisions of this
13 act upon the effective date of this section.

15 **Section 3.**

17 (a) Section 2 of this act is effective immediately
18 upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become
19 law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
20 Constitution.

1 (b) Except as provided in subsection (a) of this
2 section, this act is effective January 1, 2004.
