9 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-2608 is created to read:

- 12 agency for public assistance.

- 16 state agency for the administration of the state plan for

- 1 public assistance to administer upon terms directed by the

21 (f) This section applies only if arrangements have 22 been made for reimbursement by the department of family 23 workforce services for the administrative costs incurred by the department under this section which are attributable to 24

1 the repayment of uncollected overissuances to the

2 department of family workforce services.

Pursuant to W.S. 14 9-2-2018(b), the department of workforce services 15 16 reorganization plan dated October 15, 2001 and 17 submitted to the legislature as required by law. The legislature hereby approves that plan for 18 implementation beginning April 1, 2002. On that 19 20 date, the governor may begin transferring 21 programs specified in this section to the 22 department of workforce services. The program transfers shall be substantially completed by 23

1	June 30, 2003. The implementation plan shall be
2	subject to the following:

23	enhancement of services promoting training and

1 The memoranda shall be developed with 2 participation of the state entities specified, 3 community college districts and other entities as 4 determined appropriate by the department of 5 workforce services; 6 **Section 4.** W.S. 9-2-2006(c)(i) and 9-2-2104(a)(vi) 7 and (vii) are repealed. 8 9 10 Section 5. The governor may begin transferring programs specified in this act effective April 1, 2003. The 11 12 program transfers shall be substantially completed by June 30, 2003. 13 14 15 Section 6. This act is effective immediately upon 16 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 17 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 18 Constitution.
