5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 1-1-120(b) is amended to read:

- 9 1-1-120. Persons rendering emergency assistance
- 10 exempt from civil liability.

- 12 (b) Persons or organizations operating volunteer
- 13 ambulances or rescue vehicles supported by public or
- 14 private funds, staffed by unpaid volunteers, and which make
- 15 no charge for services rendered during medical emergencies,
- 16 and the unpaid volunteers who staff ambulances and rescue

vehicles are not liable for any civil damages for acts or 1 2 omissions in good faith in furnishing emergency medical 3 services. The immunity granted under this subsection shall 4 apply to members or employees of governmental ambulance, 5 rescue, fire or emergency units, whether or not a user or service fee is charged by the governmental agency and 6 7 whether or not the members or employees receive any compensation from the governmental agency for the services 8 9 provided under this section. This immunity does not apply 10 to acts or omissions constituting gross negligence or 11 willful or wanton misconduct.
