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- 11 (a) Effective immediately, the department of health
- 12 shall not accept or approve any applications for services
- 13 under:

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- 15 (i) The adult acquired brain injury program
- 16 authorized by 2001 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 139,
- 17 Section 335 for not more than fifty (50) individuals;

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- 2 (ii) The pilot project to reimburse assisted
- 3 living care services for not more than seventy-five (75)
- 4 individuals authorized by 2001 Wyoming Session Laws,
- 5 Chapter 184, Section 2(f).

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- 7 (b) Individuals receiving services in the programs
- specified in subsection (a) of this section as of April 1, 8
- 9 2003, may continue to receive services, subject to
- 10 legislative appropriation.

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- 12 (c) Upon termination of an individual's eligibility
- 13 for services in a program specified in subsection (a) of
- this section, the department of health shall reduce its 14
- funding for the appropriate program to the maximum number 15
- of individuals specified in subsection (a) of this section. 16

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- Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon 18
- completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 19
- 20 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
- 21 Constitution.
