## A BILL

## for

1	AN ACT relating to municipal officers; specifying and
2	clarifying provisions relating to municipal employees and
3	eligibility for municipal office; and providing for an
4	effective date.

6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
7	
8	Section 1. W.S. 22-23-301 is amended to read:
9	
10	22-23-301. Municipal officers.
11	
12	All candidates for municipal office shall be nominated at
13	the municipal primary election. In order to be eligible, a
14	candidate must be a registered voter and a resident of the
15	municipality and ward which he seeks to represent on the
16	day the petition is filed, and shall not be an employee of

1	the municipality. As used in this section, the term
2	"employee" includes only those persons receiving an hourly
3	wage or salary from a municipality. A person who provides
4	volunteer services to a municipality shall not be
5	considered an "employee" under this section based solely
6	upon coverage under the Wyoming Worker's Compensation Act
7	or other pension, death or disability program.
8	
9	Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
10	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
11	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
12	Constitution.
