1	AN ACT relating to administration of government; creating a
2	grant and loan program for economic development
3	infrastructure; establishing an account for the program;
4	providing funding for the program; providing for
5	administration; making an appropriation; specifying
6	legislative intent; and providing for an effective date.

8	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

10	Section 1. W.S. 9-12-601 through 9-12-603 are created
11	to read:

13	ARTICLE 6
14	INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM
15	
16	9-12-601. Local economy infrastructure program.
17	

The council shall establish and administer a 1 (a) 2 local economy infrastructure program as provided by this 3 article. Any city, town or joint powers board shall be 4 eligible to apply to the council for loans or grants of 5 funds from the program. An application under the program shall be on forms prescribed by and subject to rules 6 promulgated by the council. Grants and loans may be 7 applied for by a joint powers board with the approval of 8 9 all participating agencies to the joint powers agreement. 10 Grants and loans may be made by the council for economic 11 development infrastructure projects, including the purchase 12 of land, telecommunications infrastructure, rights of way, 13 airports, sewer and water projects, roads, or other 14 infrastructure determined by the council to be consistent with the purposes of this article. In adopting rules and 15 16 making grants and loans under this article the council 17 shall require all projects to be related to economic development infrastructure, 18 which shall not include 19 rehabilitation or expansion of existing infrastructure 20 unless the applicant demonstrates the rehabilitation or 21 expansion is necessary to retain an existing business or to 22 facilitate the relocation of a business to the locality of 23 the applicant. Grants shall be matching grants as

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1 determined by the council. Loans shall be made at no or 2 low interest rates. 3 4 (b) Grants and loans may be used to fund project 5 costs in accordance with approved applications and rules of the council. 6 7 8 9-12-602. Local economy infrastructure program 9 account. 10 11 There is created within the special revenue fund, the local economy infrastructure program account. Funds in the 12 13 account are continuously appropriated to the council to be 14 used only for grants and loans authorized to be made under this article. 15 16 17 9-12-603. Council duties; actions on grant and loan 18 applications. 19 All complete applications to participate in the grant and 20 21 loan program established under this article which conform 22 with the criteria established by law and rules promulgated under this article which are submitted to the council shall 23 24 be considered by the council. The council shall approve or

W.S. 9-4-601(b)(i), (iv) and by creating a 5 new paragraph (v) and 9-12-102(a)(viii) are amended to 6 read: 7 9-4-601. Distribution and use; funds, accounts, 8 9 cities and towns benefited; exception for bonus payments. 10 (b) The state treasurer shall ascertain and withhold 11 all bonus payments received from the federal government 12 13 attributable to coal, oil shale or geothermal leases of 14 federal land within Wyoming and shall distribute it as 15 follows: 16 17 (i) Fifty percent (50%), the first seven million five hundred thousand dollars (\$7,500,000.00) of which 18 19 shall be distributed as follows, but for the fiscal year 20 beginning July 1, 2004 and ending June 30, 2005 any amount 21 in excess of seven million five hundred thousand dollars 22 (\$7,500,000.00) shall be deposited to the local economy 23 infrastructure program account in accordance with paragraph 24 (v) of this subsection, and thereafter any amount in excess

9	(A) Ten percent (10%) but not to exceed one
10	million six hundred thousand dollars (\$1,600,000.00) per
11	year, to an earmarked revenue fund account which may be
12	expended by the community college commission in accordance
13	with and in addition to appropriations available under W.S.
14	21-18-205(c). For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004
15	and ending June 30, 2005, any amount in excess of one
16	million six hundred thousand dollars (\$1,600,000.00) shall
17	be deposited to the local economy infrastructure program
18	account in accordance with paragraph (v) of this
19	subsection. Thereafter any amount in excess of one million

6	and thereafter to the school capital construction account
7	established under W.S. 21-15-111(a)(i).

9	(v) For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004
10	and ending June 30, 2005, after making the distributions
11	provided for in paragraphs (i) and (iv) of this subsection,
12	fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000.00) shall be deposited
13	in the local economy infrastructure program account
14	established by W.S. 9-12-602. After this amount is
15	deposited in accordance with this paragraph, any remaining
16	amounts shall be deposited in the school capital
17	construction account established under W.S.
18	<u>21-15-111(a)(i).</u>

22	(a) As used in this act, the following terms have the
23	following meanings, except where the context clearly
24	indicates otherwise:

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2 (viii) "This act" means W.S. 9-12-101 through
3 9-12-401-9-12-603.

5 Section 3. The legislature intends that the local
6 economy infrastructure program account be maintained and

7 funded by the state by future legislative actions. This 8 act is not intended to be a substitute for existing funding 9 sources available to qualifying recipients. It is a 10 supplement to those existing sources designed to focus on 11 building economic development infrastructure.

13 Section 4. There is appropriated from the budget 14 reserve account to the local economy infrastructure program 15 account fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000.00).

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17 Section 5. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
