1 (a) The lands in Crook county described as follows 2 are designated as the Vore Buffalo Jump state park: Tract 3 B located in the Southeast Quarter of Section 34, Township 4 53 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M., as more fully described 5 by the plat thereof filed in the office of the Crook county 6 register of deeds.

7

8 (b) The Wyoming parks and cultural resources 9 commission shall prepare a plan for the development and 10 operation of the state park established under subsection 11 (a) of this section. The plan shall be presented to the 12 joint travel, recreation, wildlife and cultural resources 13 interim committee no later than November 1, 2003.

14

15 (c) The department of state parks and cultural 16 resources and the Wyoming parks and cultural resources 17 commission shall administer and operate the state park 18 created by this section in accordance with the plan 19 developed under subsection (b) of this section, unless 20 otherwise directed by the legislature.

Section 2. Fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of state parks and cultural resources to prepare a plan for

1 the development and operation of the state park established 2 under this act.

4 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon
5 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
6 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
7 Constitution.
