A BILL

for

- 1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming
- 2 Constitution to modify the prohibition against the
- 3 legislature limiting the amount of damages that may be
- 4 recovered for causing personal injury or death of any
- 5 person.

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- 7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,
- 8 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting
- 9 separately, concurring therein:

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- 11 Section 1. The following proposal to amend Wyoming
- 12 Constitution, Article 10, Section 4 is proposed for
- 13 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
- 14 next general election for approval or rejection to become
- 15 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a
- 16 majority of the electors at the election:

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2 Article 10, Section 4. Damages for personal injuries 3 or death; worker's compensation.

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5 No law shall be enacted limiting the amount of actual 6 economic damages to be recovered for causing the injury or 7 death of any person. The legislature may enact laws to 8 limit the amount of noneconomic damages to be recovered for causing the injury or death of any person. Any contract or 9 agreement with any employee waiving any right to recover 10 damages for causing the death or injury of any employee 11 12 shall be void. As to all extrahazardous employments the 13 legislature shall provide by law for the accumulation and 14 maintenance of a fund or funds out of which shall be paid compensation as may be fixed by law according to proper 15 16 classifications to each person injured in such employment or to the dependent families of such as die as the result 17 18 of such injuries, except in case of injuries due solely to 19 the culpable negligence of the injured employee. The fund or funds shall be accumulated, paid into the state treasury 20 and maintained in such manner as may be provided by law. 21 22 Monies in the fund shall be expended only for compensation 23 authorized by this section, for administration 24 management of the Worker's Compensation Act, debt service

related to the fund and for workplace safety programs 1 2 conducted by the state as authorized by law. The right of 3 each employee to compensation from the fund shall be in lieu of and shall take the place of any and all rights of 4 5 action against any employer contributing as required by law 6 to the fund in favor of any person or persons by reason of 7 the injuries or death. Subject to conditions specified by 8 law, the legislature may allow employments not designated 9 extrahazardous to be covered by the state fund at the option of the employer. To the extent an employer elects 10 to be covered by the state fund and contributes to the fund 11

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15 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State shall endorse 16 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

immunity as provided for extrahazardous employments.

as required by law, the employer shall enjoy the same

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This amendment would allow the Wyoming legislature to enact laws to limit the amount of noneconomic damages that may be recovered for injury or death of any person.
