LUBNAU SWEARING IN CEREMONY SCHEDULED FOR SEPTEMBER 3, 2004 IN HOUSE CHAMBERS

CHEYENNE – Attorney Tom Lubnau, of Gillette, will be sworn in as a member of the 57th Wyoming Legislature on Friday, September 3, 2004 at 3:00 p.m. in Cheyenne in the House Chambers of the Wyoming Capitol. Wyoming Supreme Court Chief Justice, William Hill, will administer the oath of office and preside over the ceremony. Members of the media are encouraged to attend this brief ceremony.

The Wyoming Constitution Article 6 Sections 20 and 21 provide that new legislators will take their oath of office in the legislative chamber in which they will serve. The Campbell County Commissioners appointed Lubnau on August 20, 2004 to fill the vacant Wyoming House District 31 seat of former Representative Jene Jansen. Jansen resigned from his House seat to move to California. Lubnau is with the firm of Lubnau, Bailey and Dumbrill. – **End** –
