Oregon Trail state veteran's cemetery.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to veterans; providing an appropriation for
2 the development of a master plan for the Oregon Trail state
3 veteran's cemetery; requiring a report; and providing for
4 an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** There is appropriated from the general
9 fund to the adjutant general nineteen thousand four hundred
10 fifty dollars (\$19,450.00) for the development of a master
11 plan for the Oregon Trail state veteran's cemetery. The
12 plan shall be developed in accordance with federal
13 requirements to allow for reimbursement of expenditures for
14 the development, expansion and operation of the cemetery.
15 The plan shall recommend appropriate means to allow
16 disabled persons to visit grave sites. To the extent

1 reimbursement is available, the adjutant general shall
2 apply to appropriate federal agencies for reimbursement of
3 expenditures for the development of the master plan. Any
4 reimbursement of expenditures made under this section shall
5 be deposited with the state treasurer to be placed in the
6 general fund.

7

8 **Section 2.** The adjutant general shall report to the
9 joint transportation and highways interim committee not
10 later than September 15, 2004, regarding the development of
11 a master plan for the Oregon Trail state veteran's
12 cemetery. The report shall include a timeline for future
13 expansion and development, anticipated costs for each phase
14 of expansion and development and the available funding
15 sources for expansion and development.

16

17 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
18 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
19 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
20 Constitution.
