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5 (c) The commission shall elect from its members a chairman, a vice-chairman and a secretary. Vacancies in 6 7 these offices shall be filled by the commission from its membership. The commission shall meet at least once every 8 9 three (3) months. Appointments by the governor shall be made within thirty (30) days of expiration of membership 10 terms. Nominee lists shall be furnished within ten (10) 11 12 days upon expiration of any membership term. Each voting 13 member shall serve a three (3) year term. A vacancy on the commission shall be filled for the unexpired term by the 14 governor. from a list of two (2) names submitted within ten 15 16 (10) days of the vacancy by the appointing association or 17 agency.
