23	(a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of
24	this section, no person shall operate a passenger vehicle

in this state unless each child who is a passenger in that 1 2 vehicle and who is eight (8) years of age or under, and has 3 not reached his ninth birthday or who weighs eighty (80) 4 pounds or less, is properly secured in a child safety 5 restraint system in a seat of the vehicle other than the front seat, except if the vehicle is only equipped with one 6 7 (1) row of seats, or if all safety belts in the rows of seats behind the front seat are in use by other child 8 9 passengers in the vehicle, the child may be properly secured in a child safety restraint system in the front 10 11 passenger seat of the vehicle. Any child who has reached 12 his ninth birthday or who weighs more than eighty (80) 13 pounds shall not be required to be in a child safety 14 restraint system while traveling in a passenger vehicle in this state, except that if the lap and shoulder belts of 15 16 the vehicle will not fit properly across the collarbone, 17 chest and hips of the child and may pose a danger to the neck, face or abdominal area of the child in the event of a 18 19 crash or sudden stop, the child shall be secured in an 20 appropriate child restraint system which meets standards 21 prescribed by 49 C.F.R. 571.213.
