A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to taxation and revenue; providing a sales  
2 tax exemption for food and meals provided to employees as  
3 specified; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 39-15-105(a)(iii) by creating a new  
8 subparagraph (J) is amended to read:

10 **39-15-105. Exemptions.**

12 (a) The following sales or leases are exempt from the  
13 excise tax imposed by this article:

1           (iii) For the purpose of exempting sales of  
2 services and tangible personal property consumed in  
3 production, the following are exempt:

5                   (J) The cost of food or meals furnished by  
6 a food establishment licensed under W.S. 35-7-124 without  
7 charge to an employee for consumption on the premises is  
8 not taxable either to the establishment or the employee.

10           **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2004.
