1	AN ACT relating to communicable diseases; clarifying
2	provisions pertaining to the investigation of communicable
3	diseases and quarantine by the state and county health
4	officers; and providing for an effective date.
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6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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8	Section 1. W.S. 35-4-103 is amended to read:
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10	35-4-103. Investigation of diseases; quarantine;
11	regulation of travel; employment of police officers to
12	enforce quarantine; report of county health officer;
13	supplies and expenses.
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15	It shall be the duty of <u>T</u>he department of health <mark>shall</mark> ,
16	immediately after the receipt of the information that there

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is any smallpox, cholera, scarlet fever, diphtheria or 1 2 other infectious or contagious disease, which is a menace 3 to the public health, in any portion of this state, to 4 order the county health officer by telegram or telephone, 5 if he is not at hand to proceed immediately to said case and there to immediately investigate said the case or 6 7 cases, and to report to the state health officer, by telephone or telegram, the results of said the 8 9 investigation., and it shall be the duty of The state 10 health officer, shall subject to W.S. 35-4-112 and if in 11 his judgment the occasion requires, to-direct the county 12 health officer to declare said the infected place to be in 13 quarantine. and to The county health officer shall place 14 any and all restrictions upon the ingress and egress thereat at this location as in his judgment, or in the 15 16 judgment of the state health officer shall be is necessary 17 to prevent the spread of the disease from the infected locality.; and it shall be the duty of The said county 18 health officer when he shall have declared shall upon 19 20 declaring any city, or town or other place to be in 21 quarantine, so to control the population of said the city, town or other place, and make such disposition of the same, 22 as shall in his judgment best protect protects the people 23 24 and at the same time prevent prevents the spread of the 2004

And when deemed If necessary for 2 the protection of the public health and subject to W.S. 3 35-4-112, the state health officer shall establish and 4 maintain a state quarantine, and shall enforce $\frac{such}{such}$ 5 practical regulations regarding railroads, stage lines, or other lines of travel into and out of the state of Wyoming 6 as they so deem proper and necessary for the protection of 7 public health., and The expenses 8 the incurred in 9 maintaining said the state quarantine shall be paid out of 10 the funds of the state treasury appropriated for this 11 purpose and in the manner in which other expenses of the 12 department are audited and paid. The county health officer $_{\overline{L}}$ 13 or the department, are hereby authorized to may employ a sufficient number of police officers who shall be under the 14 control of the county health officer, to enforce and carry 15 16 out any and all quarantine regulations the department may 17 prescribe., which said The regulations shall be made public in the most practicable manner, in the several counties, 18 19 cities, towns or other places where the quarantine may be 20 is established. And where If the quarantine is established 21 by the county health officer, he shall make immediate 22 immediately report of his actions and doings in the 23 premises to the state health officer. and from time to time 24 so long as quarantine shall continue. It shall also be the

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1	duty of <u>T</u>he county health officer to <u>shall</u> furnish all
2	supplies , in the nature of clothing, provisions,
3	construction of pesthouses or other things necessary for
4	the maintaining of such <u>the</u> quarantine<u>.</u>,and <u>U</u>pon
5	certificate of the county health officer $_{ au}$ approved by the
6	director of the state department of health <u>,</u> it shall be the
7	duty of the county commissioners of any county where such a
8	quarantine has been established , to <u>shall</u> issue warrant or
9	warrants to the proper parties for the payment of all
10	expenses, together with the expense of employing sufficient
11	police force <u>,</u> to maintain and enforce said <u>the</u> quarantine.
12	For purposes of this act, "state health officer" means as
13	defined in W.S. 9-2-101(f) <u>9-2-103(e)</u>.
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15	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2004.
