10 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-2-508 is created to read:

- 12 6-2-508. Assault by contamination; aggravated assault
- 13 by contamination; penalties.

- 15 (a) A person who purposefully or knowingly causes one
- 16 (1) or more contaminating substances to be introduced into

1 the food or drink of or otherwise be ingested by another

person without that person's prior knowledge or consent is 2

3 guilty of assault by contamination.

5 (b) A person who purposefully or knowingly causes one

(1) or more contaminating substances to be introduced into 6

the food or drink of or otherwise ingested by another 7

person without that person's prior knowledge or consent is 8

9 quilty of aggravated assault by contamination if:

10

(i) The contaminating substance is infected with 11

12 or otherwise contains a serious contagious or infectious

13 disease; or

14

(ii) The person used the contaminating substance 15

16 to substantially impair the other person's power to

17 appraise or control his conduct.

19 (c) Assault by contamination is a misdemeanor

20 punishable by imprisonment for not more than six (6)

21 months, a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars

22 (\$750.00), or both. Aggravated assault by contamination is

a felony punishable by not more than ten (10) years 23

24 imprisonment.

2 (d) As used in this section:

4 (i) "Bodily tissues, fluids or wastes" means
5 substances or secretions from the human body, including but

6 not limited to skin, flesh, blood, saliva, semen, urine and

7 feces;

9 (ii) "Contaminating substance" includes bodily

10 tissues, fluids or wastes and controlled substances;

12 (iii) "Controlled substance" means as defined in

13 W.S. 35-7-1002 (a) (iv);

15 (iv) "Serious contagious or infectious disease"

16 means any disease or contagion that bears a substantial

17 probability of death or grave physical or mental injury or

18 debilitation for any person who comes into contact with or

19 contracts the disease or contagion, including but not

20 limited to human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) and

21 hepatitis.

Definitions. 2 (a) As used in W.S. 6-1-101 through 6-10-203 unless 3 4 otherwise defined: 5 (xii) "Violent felony" means murder, 6 manslaughter, kidnapping, sexual assault in the first or 7 second degree, robbery, aggravated assault, aggravated 8 9 assault by contamination, aircraft hijacking, arson in the first or second degree or aggravated burglary; 10 11 12 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 13 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 14 15 Constitution.
