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6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-12-601(b) is amended to read:

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- 9-12-601. Wyoming business ready community program;
- 11 purpose; creation; rulemaking.

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- 13 (b) The council shall establish and administer a
- 14 Wyoming business ready community program as provided by
- 15 this article. Any city, town or county may submit an
- 16 application to the council for a grant or loan under the

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1 program on forms prescribed by and subject to rules promulgated by the council. Grants or loans may be applied 2 3 for by a joint powers board with the approval of all 4 participating agencies to the joint powers agreement. 5 Grants and loans may be made by the council for economic or educational development infrastructure projects, including 6 7 the purchase of land, buildings, facilities, telecommunications infrastructure, rights of way, airports, 8 sewer and water projects, roads, landscaping, recreational 9 10 and convention facilities or other infrastructure 11 determined by the council to be consistent with the purposes of this article. In adopting rules and making 12 13 grants and loans under this article the council shall 14 require all projects to be related to economic or educational development infrastructure, which shall not 15 16 include rehabilitation or expansion of existing 17 infrastructure unless the applicant demonstrates the rehabilitation or expansion is necessary to retain an 18 existing business or to facilitate the relocation of a 19 20 business to the locality of the applicant. All grants, 21 loans or cooperative agreements made under this article 22 shall be referred by the council to the state loan and investment board for final approval or disapproval. The 23

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1 state loan and investment board may adopt rules as

2 necessary to implement its duties under this article.

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4 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon

5 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

6 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

7 Constitution.
