## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to the University of Wyoming; establishing
- 2 the athletics challenge account to be used for funding a
- 3 university athletic facilities matching program; defining
- 4 terms and specifying program conditions; providing for
- 5 reversion of funds; and providing for an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 13 UNIVERSITY OF WYOMING ATHLETICS CHALLENGE FUND

15 **21-16-1001.** Definitions.

1

2 (a) As used in this article:

3

4 (i) "Challenge account" means the university

5 athletics challenge account established under W.S.

6 21-16-1002;

7

8 (ii) "Qualifying contribution" means a transfer

9 of money or other property of a value of not less than

10 twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) to the University

11 of Wyoming foundation to be expended exclusively for

12 university intercollegiate athletic facilities consistent

13 with the 2003 intercollegiate athletics plan approved by

14 the university board of trustees. The commitment for a

15 qualifying contribution or the contribution itself shall be

16 made during the period of time beginning September 13,

17 2003, and ending December 31, 2006. The contribution shall

18 be actually received by the University of Wyoming

19 foundation on or before December 31, 2008.

21 21-16-1002. University athletics challenge account.

22

23 (a) The university athletics challenge account is

24 created within the earmarked revenue fund.

1

2 (b) The state treasurer shall invest amounts

3 deposited within the account in accordance with law. All

4 investment earnings shall be credited to the general fund.

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6 21-16-1003. Athletics challenge matching program;

7 state treasurer to administer program account; matching

8 payments; conditions; annual reports; reversion of

9 appropriations.

10

11 (a) The state treasurer shall administer the

12 university athletics challenge account established under

13 this article. The following shall apply:

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15 (i) To the extent that funds are available in

16 the challenge account, the state treasurer shall match each

17 qualifying contribution actually received by the University

18 of Wyoming foundation by transferring from the challenge

19 account to the university an amount equal to the amount of

20 the qualifying contribution. Qualifying contributions made

21 directly to the university shall be considered qualifying

22 contributions to the foundation for purposes of this

23 article. The university shall expend both the qualifying

24 contributions and the matching funds solely for the cost of

1 establishing new or renovating existing university

2 intercollegiate athletics facilities consistent with the

3 intercollegiate athletics plan approved by the

4 university board of trustees. Authorized expenditures for

5 intercollegiate athletic facilities include but are not

limited to all expenditures necessary for planning, 6

designing, procuring contractors, construction management 7

and actual construction; 8

received by the foundation;

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10 (ii) The state treasurer shall make transfers to 11 the university under this section not later than the end of 12 the calendar quarter following the quarter during which the qualifying contribution is received. If a qualifying 13 14 contribution is made through a series of payments or transfers, no matching funds shall be transferred by the 15 state treasurer until the total value of all payments or 16 17 transfers actually received toward the contribution totals least twenty-five thousand dollars 18 (\$25,000.00). Thereafter, matching funds shall be transferred as payments 19 20 transfers toward that qualifying contribution

23 The state treasurer shall distribute funds (iii) 24 or encumber funds for future distribution in the case of a

1 written commitment, to match a qualifying contribution

2 based on the order in which each qualifying contribution is

3 actually received or in which a written commitment to make

4 a qualifying contribution is received by the foundation.

5 Matching funds shall not be distributed or encumbered in

excess of the amount within the challenge account. 6 No

matching funds shall be transferred to the university 7

except to match qualifying contributions actually received. 8

9 The state treasurer shall rescind an encumbrance if the

10 university notifies him that a donor who made a commitment

11 will not make a qualifying contribution that is eligible

12 for matching funds under this section;

13

(iv) For the purpose of calculating the matching 14

amount only, the state treasurer shall use the value of a 15

qualifying contribution based on its fair market value at 16

17 the time the contribution is received by the university

foundation. The university shall provide evidence of fair 18

market value as the state treasurer requires for each 19

20 qualifying contribution. The state treasurer's office

21 shall not bear any costs associated with providing

22 evidence;

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1	(V)	Through	calendar	year	2008,	the	University
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2 of Wyoming shall on or before October 1 of each calendar

3 year submit a report to the state treasurer from the

4 university foundation regarding the endowment matching

5 program established under this section for the preceding

6 fiscal year. The report shall include a financial summary

7 and a review of the accomplishments resulting from

8 endowment program expenditures. The state treasurer shall

9 distribute the report to the governor and the legislature;

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11 (vi) Any unexpended funds remaining in the

12 account at the end of the collection period shall revert to

13 the general fund.

14

15 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon

16 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

17 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

18 Constitution.
