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(d) Except as provided in this subsection, the 6

7 immunities provided by subsection (b) of this section are

not available to a volunteer health care professional, if 8

9 at the time of an alleged injury, death or loss to person

10 property, the volunteer health care professional

11 involved was performing an operation or delivering a baby.

12 This subsection does not apply to a volunteer health care

13 professional who provides diagnosis, care or treatment or

14 performs an operation or delivers a baby when necessary to

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17 In order for the immunity under subsection (b) of

this section to apply and before the rendering of any 18

services by the volunteer health care professional at the 19

20 nonprofit health care facility, there must be a written

21 agreement between the volunteer health care professional

22 and the facility pursuant to which the volunteer health

care professional will provide medical, dental or health 23

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1 care related diagnosis, care or treatment under the control

2 of the facility to patients of the facility.

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4 (f) A nonprofit health care facility entering into a 5 written agreement under subsection (e) of this section shall maintain liability coverage of not less than one 6 7 million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence, except that no such coverage shall be required to be maintained by the 8 9 facility if such coverage is maintained by all volunteer 10 health care professionals rendering services at the facility. A nonprofit health care facility shall be liable 11 negligent acts of a volunteer health care 12 for the 13 professional providing diagnosis, care or treatment at the 14 facility only in the circumstances and to the extent the
