6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general 8

fund to the legislative service office the following 9

specified amounts, or as much thereof as may be necessary, 10

to pay the costs and expenses of the Wyoming legislature 11

through June 30, 2006: 12

[Additional Travel] Not to exceed twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$28,000.00) shall be used to reimburse 10 11 legislators for mileage for one (1) additional trip to 12 travel to their residence and return to the legislature 13 during the 2005 general session and for one (1) additional trip to travel to their residence and return to the 14 legislature during the 2006 budget session. 15 16 17 2. [Mid-Session Recess - Per Diem] Subject to management council approval, legislators may be authorized 18 not to exceed five (5) additional days per diem for a mid-19 20 recess during the 2005 general session. 21 Notwithstanding W.S. 28-5-101, legislative salary shall not 22 be paid for any days the legislature is in recess under

this footnote. Not to exceed fifty-three thousand five

2 per diem under this footnote.

3. [Legislative Computer Equipment] Not to exceed one hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$170,000.00) shall be

hundred fifty dollars (\$53,550.00) shall be expended for

6 used for the lease or purchase of laptop computers and

7 support systems. Expenditure of funds under this footnote

8 shall be subject to approval by the select committee on

9 legislative technology. Legislative laptop computers being

10 replaced shall be sold in accordance with Management

11 Council directives. Any proceeds received from the sale of

12 any laptop computer shall be deposited into the general

13 fund and are hereby reappropriated to the legislative

14 service office to be used for the purchase of replacement

15 laptop computers.

17 **Section 2.** [Standard Provision] - The Management
18 Council may transfer funds from one expense category to

19 another under section 1 of this act as the activities of

20 the legislature may require.

Section 3. [Standard Provision] - The appropriation

for out-of-state travel under this act shall be used to

reimburse legislators for documented legislative travel and

- per diem expenses to meetings including, but not limited 1
- 2 to, the National Conference of State Legislatures, the
- 3 Council of State Governments and the Energy Council.
- 4 Reimbursements shall be made with the permission of the
- 5 Speaker of the House or the President of the Senate, in
- accordance with policies of the Management Council. 6

**Section 4.** [Carry Forward of Prior Appropriations] 8

- (a) Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008, 9-2-1012 (e) and 10
- 9-4-207(a), the unobligated portions of the following 11
- appropriations shall not revert on June 30, 2004, and are 12
- 13 hereby reappropriated to the legislative service office
- subject to any conditions in the original appropriations: 14

- (i) Appropriation for committee staff support 16

- 21 (ii) Any balance in the constituent service

- June 30, 2004, is appropriated to fund the constituent 23

2 30, 2006.

4 Section 5. [Artwork/Facilities Appropriations] There

5 is appropriated from the general fund to the legislative

6 service office:

8 (a) Sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000.00) for the

9 restoration of legislator composite photograph frames.

10

11 (b) Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) for

12 enhancement of the artwork security system.

13

14 (c) Eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000.00) for the

15 remodeling of chambers work stations.

16

17 (d) Fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) for

18 committee room signage.

19

20 (e) Twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000.00) for the

21 restoration of historic benches.

22

23 (f) Five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) for the repair

6

24 or replacement of miscellaneous furnishings.

2 Section 6. [Facility Enhancement Study] The select committee on school facilities shall conduct a study of 3 4 school district enhancements to school buildings and 5 facilities. The study shall provide recommendations on revenue mechanisms available to local districts to fund 6 7 enhancements and to fund the maintenance of enhancements. Fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) is appropriated from 8 9 the general fund to the legislative service office to fund

12 **Section 7.** [Effective Immediate Appropriations]

the study required under this section.

13

(a) The legislative service office is authorized four 14 (4) additional full-time positions. Duties 15 responsibilities of these positions shall be assigned by 16 17 the Management Council. There is appropriated from the general fund to the legislative service office seventy-four 18 thousand dollars (\$74,000.00) to fund these positions 19 20 through June 30, 2004. Unexpended funds appropriated under 21 this subsection shall revert to the general fund on June 30, 2004. 22

(b) For the period ending December 31, 2004, there is 1

2 appropriated sixty-four thousand seven hundred fifty

3 dollars (\$64,750.00) from the general fund to the

4 legislative service office to be used to reimburse

5 specified officers and ranking members of the House of

Representatives and the Senate for clerical expenses 6

7 incurred in performing the duties required by their

positions during the time the legislature is not in 8

9 session. Reimbursement under this section shall be subject

10 to the following:

12 (i) Expenses shall be reimbursed quarterly upon

submission of a claim form by the officer or member 13

verifying the expenses incurred; 14

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(ii) Claim forms shall be submitted to the 16

17 legislative service office not later than the last day of

the month following the calendar quarter for which the 18

reimbursement is claimed; 19

21 (iii) Clerical expenses shall include payment

22 for services performed by part-time secretarial or clerical

23 assistants and other similar expenses authorized by

24 Management Council policy;

2 (iv) No person shall be deemed eligible for 3 reimbursement under more than one status category listed

4 under paragraph (v) of this subsection;

5

6 (v) The amount of the reimbursement shall not 7 exceed the following annual amounts:

8

9 (A) For the Speaker of the House and 10 President of the Senate, one thousand five hundred dollars 11 (\$1,500.00);

12

(B) For the Senate Majority Floor Leader,

Vice President, Minority Floor Leader, Minority Whip and

Minority Caucus Chairman, and the House Majority Floor

Leader, Speaker Pro Tempore, Majority Whip, Minority Floor

Leader, Minority Whip and Minority Caucus Chairman, one

thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$1,250.00); and

(C) For the Chairman and the ranking minority member of each standing committee listed in House Rule 4-1 1 through 10 and Senate Rule 7-1 1 through 10, the Management Audit Committee, the Select Water Committee, the Select Committee on Capital Financing and Investments, and

9

1 the Select Committee on School Facilities, one thousand

2 dollars (\$1,000.00).

3

4 (vi) Unexpended funds appropriated under this

5 subsection shall revert to the general fund on March 31,

6 2005.

7

8 (c) There is appropriated from the general fund to

9 the legislative service office six thousand dollars

10 (\$6,000.00) or as much thereof as is necessary for the

11 purchase of two (2) color printers, one (1) for the senate

12 and one (1) for the house.

13

14 (d) There is appropriated from the general fund to

15 the legislative service office ten thousand dollars

16 (\$10,000.00) or as much thereof as is necessary for the

17 purchase of a microphone and speaker system for room 302 of

18 the capitol building.

19

1 Section 8. [Effective Date] - Sections 4 and 7 of

2 this act are effective immediately upon completion of all

3 acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by

4 Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution. The

5 balance of this act is effective July 1, 2004.
