Task force on capitol facilities.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the administration of government;
2 creating a joint legislative and executive task force to
3 address space allocation requirements as specified;
4 providing appropriations; and providing for an effective
5 date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.**

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11 (a) There is created the joint legislative and
12 executive task force on capitol facilities.

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14 (b) The task force shall be comprised of:

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16 (i) The governor or his designee;

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1 (ii) The secretary of state or his designee;

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3 (iii) The state treasurer or her designee;

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5 (iv) The state auditor or his designee;

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7 (v) The state superintendent of public
8 instruction or his designee;

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10 (vi) The president, vice president, majority and
11 minority floor leaders of the Wyoming senate;

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13 (vii) The speaker, speaker pro tempore, majority
14 and minority floor leaders of the Wyoming house of
15 representatives;

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17 (viii) The two (2) legislative liaisons to the
18 state building commission and the chairman of the
19 appropriations committee of the house of representatives;
20 and

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22 (ix) The chief justice of the supreme court or
23 his designee.

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1 (c) The senate president shall serve as chairman of
2 the task force.

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4 (d) The task force shall:

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6 (i) Conduct a comprehensive review of space
7 requirements of the state-wide elected officials and the
8 legislature;

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10 (ii) Review previous reports and studies and
11 consider space allocation alternatives including the
12 possible relocation of offices and the lease, purchase or
13 construction of additional facilities;

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15 (iii) Develop maintenance, repair and
16 restoration priorities for the state capitol and existing
17 facilities within the capitol complex;

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19 (iv) Develop both long and short term proposals
20 for addressing space requirements both in the state capitol
21 building and in the capitol complex;

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23 (v) Periodically report their findings and
24 recommendations to the state building commission, the

1 legislative management council and the joint appropriations
2 interim committee;

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4 (vi) Submit specific project recommendations to
5 the state building commission for approval and
6 authorization of funding; and

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8 (vii) Recommend to the management council
9 statutory changes that may be required to implement project
10 recommendations.

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12 (e) Staff support for the task force shall be
13 provided by the legislative service office, the capital
14 facilities staff of the department of administration and
15 information and by any state agency upon request.

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17 **Section 2.**

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19 (a) Forty thousand dollars (\$40,000.00) is
20 appropriated from the general fund to the legislative
21 service office to fund the interim meetings and activities
22 of the task force and to contract with appropriate
23 professionals as necessary to complete the task force

1 study. Expenditure of funds under this subsection shall be
2 subject to management council approval.

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4 (b) Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000.00)
5 is appropriated from the general fund to the state building
6 commission to be used to implement projects recommended by
7 the task force and approved by the commission.

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9 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
10 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
11 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
12 Constitution.
