AN ACT relating to carbon storage; extending provisions relating to carbon sequestration activities; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. 2001 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 173, sections 6 and 7 as amended by 2002 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 75, section 1 are amended to read:

Section 6. There is a one (1) time appropriation from the budget reserve account to the department of agriculture thirty-five thousand six hundred dollars (\$35,600.00), or as much thereof as is necessary, for purposes of this act. There is also appropriated from the general fund to the department of agriculture thirty-five thousand six hundred dollars (\$35,600.00), or as much thereof as is necessary, for purposes of this act. Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008, 9-2-1012(e) and 9-2-207(a) any monies remaining from this appropriation shall not lapse on June 30, 2002 and are hereby appropriated to the department for purposes of this act.

Section 7. This act is repealed effective July 1, $\frac{2004}{2009}$.
