FIFTY-SEVENTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING
2004 BUDGET SESSION

AN ACT relating to carbon storage; extending provisions relating to carbon sequestration activities; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. 2001 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 173, sections 6 and 7 as amended by 2002 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 75, section 1 are amended to read:

Section 6. There is a one (1) time appropriation from the budget reserve account to the department of agriculture thirty-five thousand six hundred dollars (\$35,600.00), or as much thereof as is necessary, for purposes of this act. There is also appropriated from the general fund to the department of agriculture thirty-five thousand six hundred dollars (\$35,600.00), or as much thereof as is necessary, for purposes of this act. Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008, 9-2-1012(e) and 9-2-207(a) any monies remaining from this appropriation shall not lapse ~~on June 30, 2002~~ and are hereby appropriated to the department for purposes of this act.

Section 7. This act is repealed effective July 1, ~~2004~~2009.

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Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
