AN ACT relating to civil actions and judicial proceedings; modifying the time in which a dormant judgment may be revived as specified; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 1-16-503 is amended to read:

1-16-503. Revivor of dormant judgments; limitations on time to revive.

- $\underline{\text{(a)}}$ No action shall be brought to revive a judgment after $\underline{\text{twenty-one}}$ $\underline{\text{(21)}}$ $\underline{\text{ten}}$ $\underline{\text{(10)}}$ years after it becomes dormant, unless the party entitled to bring the action was:
- $\underline{\text{(i)}}$ A minor or subject to any other legal disability at the time the judgment became dormant, in which case the action may be brought within fifteen (15) years after the disability has ceased; \cdot or
- which case the action shall be brought within twenty-one (21) years.
