AN ACT relating to the Wyoming Criminal Code; including qualified employees of state parks and historic sites within the definition of "peace officer"; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

**Section 1.** W.S. 6-1-104(a)(vi) by creating a new subparagraph (P) is amended to read:

## 6-1-104. Definitions.

- (a) As used in W.S. 6-1-101 through 6-10-203 unless otherwise defined:
- (vi) "Peace officer" includes the following
  officers assigned to duty in the state of Wyoming:
- (P) Any superintendent, assistant superintendent or full-time park ranger of any state park or historic site who has qualified pursuant to W.S. 9-1-701 through 9-1-707, when acting within the boundaries of the state park or historic site or when responding to a request to assist other peace officers acting within the scope of their official duties in their own jurisdiction.
