

ENROLLED ACT NO. 74, HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

FIFTY-SEVENTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING
2004 BUDGET SESSION

AN ACT relating to agriculture and animals; providing funding for brucellosis testing, supplies and equipment as specified; providing an appropriation; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. One million six hundred fifty thousand six hundred five dollars (\$1,650,605.00) is appropriated from the general fund to the livestock board for the compensation of livestock producers related to the testing for brucellosis in this state. The compensation for surveillance testing may be paid at not more than three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50) per head of cattle actually tested. Payment shall be made monthly directly to accredited veterinarians who perform brucellosis testing as mandated by rule of the Wyoming livestock board or the United States department of agriculture animal plant and health inspection service upon submission of a notarized invoice indicating the number of head tested, ownership of the animals tested and testing location. Up to one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000.00) of this appropriation may be expended by the livestock board to purchase necessary brucellosis testing equipment, supplies and postage.
