AN ACT relating to state holidays; modifying the date for Native American Day; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 8-4-105(a) and (b) is amended to read:

8-4-105. Native American Day.

- (a) In recognition of the North American Indian, the third second Friday in September May is designated as "Native American Day". The day shall be appropriately observed in the public schools of the state, by state and local government and by organizations within the state.
- (b) The governor, not later than September 1 April 15 of each year, shall issue a proclamation requesting proper observance of "Native American Day".
