AN ACT relating to mines and minerals; providing for the filing of mining claims as specified; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 30-1-101(a)(intro) is amended to read:

30-1-101. Recording mining claims required; requisites of certificate.

(a) A discoverer of any mineral lead, lode, ledge or vein shall, within ~~sixty (60)~~ ninety (90) days from the date of discovery, cause the claim to be recorded in the office of the county clerk and ex officio register of deeds of the county within which the claim may exist, by a location certificate which shall contain the following facts:
