AN ACT relating to state parks, recreation areas, archeological and historic sites; modifying provisions relating to the disposition and use of fees from state parks, recreation areas, archeological sites and historic site permits; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 36-4-121(h) is amended to read:

36-4-121. Permits to use state parks, recreation areas and historic sites.

- (h) The funds received by the department from the sale of the permits shall be deposited as follows:
- (i) Eighty percent (80%) shall be deposited in a capital construction account within the enterprise fund and may be expended by the division for capital construction projects subject to approval and site interpretation such as exhibits, signage and displays as approved by the legislature.
- (ii) Twenty percent (20%) shall be deposited in the general fund.
