6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8	Section 1. W.S. 11-19-102 is amended to read:

10	11-19-102. Duty of public to report diseases to state
11	veterinarian; reportable disease list; failure to comply or
12	obstruction of duty; penalties.

14	(a) Any person who knows or suspects that there is

upon his premises any contagious or infectious disease

among domestic animals, shall immediately report the same 1 2 to the state veterinarian. The state veterinarian may 3 establish a reportable disease list for any contagious or 4 infectious disease deemed to be a threat to animals. 5 Information collected in response to the reportable disease list shall be considered confidential proprietary 6 7 information. Access to any information collected under the reportable disease list shall be limited to the person who 8 9 reported the disease, the state veterinarian, the Wyoming 10 livestock board, the state veterinary laboratory, the 11 Wyoming game and fish director and any state or federal 12 inspector, public health official or peace officer, who is 13 actively involved in the investigation of an outbreak or 14 suspected outbreak of the contagious or infectious disease. (b) A failure to report, or any attempt to conceal 16

17 the existence of the disease or to willfully or maliciously obstruct or resist the veterinarian in the discharge of his 18 duty is a misdemeanor. Any person convicted of any of the 19 20 above acts or omissions shall be punished as provided in 21 W.S. 11-1-103.
