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7	<b>Section 1.</b> W.S. 7-4-104(a)(i)(intro), (E) and by
8	creating new paragraphs (iv) through (vi) is amended to

13	(a) As used in this chapter:

1	(i) "Coroner's case" means a case involving a
2	death which was not anticipated and which may involve any
3	of the following conditions:

5	(E) The deceased was unattended: or had not
6	seen a physician within six (6) months prior to death;
7	
8	(iv) "Anticipated death" means the death of an
9	individual who had been diagnosed by a physician acting
10	within the scope of his license as being afflicted with a
11	terminal condition, and there is no cause to believe the
12	death occurred for any reasons other than those associated
13	with the terminal condition;

15	(v) "Terminal condition" means as defined in
16	W.S. 35-22-101(a)(ix);
17 18 19 20 21 22 23	*** STAFF COMMENTS *** W.S. 35-22-101(a)(ix) deals with living wills and defines "terminal condition" as a condition caused by injury, disease or illness from which, to a reasonable degree of medical certainty, there can be no recovery and death is imminent.
24	(vi) "Unattended" means the deceased had not
25	been under the care of a physician acting within the scope
26	of his license within sixty (60) days immediately prior to
27	the date of death.
