A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to elections; providing for a permanent
- 2 elections fund to pay for specified expenses in conducting
- 3 future elections which are subject to federal requirements
- 4 of the Help America Vote Act; providing an appropriation;
- 5 and providing for an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-2-122 is created to read:

10

- 11 22-2-122. State and federal share of qualified
- 12 election expenses; permanent election fund.

13

- 14 (a) An account is created to consist of federal funds
- 15 received by the state of Wyoming under the Help America
- 16 Vote Act which are not expended nor obligated on or before

1 January 1, 2007. In addition, the account shall contain

2 state appropriations as may be authorized by the

3 legislature. Interest and investment income accruing from

4 the corpus of the account shall be credited to the account.

5

The purpose of the account is to fund future 6 7 costs of replacement and maintenance of voting systems and the state wide voter registration system, and other ongoing 8 9 costs, which have been and will continue to be required by the Help America Vote Act following the 2006 federal 10 11 elections. During calendar year 2005, if the entire amount 12 of federal funding authorized under the Help America Vote 13 Act is not received by the state of Wyoming and additional funds are required for the replacement of voting systems in 14 counties, any portion of state appropriations made into the 15 account may be obligated and expended to complete the 16 17 replacement of voting systems as required under the Help Act following review 18 America Vote by the joint 19 appropriations interim committee and the joint 20 corporations, elections and political subdivisions interim

23 (c) Commencing in 2007, and annually thereafter, the 24 Wyoming secretary of state shall compile and document

committee and approval by the governor.

requests from each county for disbursements from the 1

2 account and any state expenses which appear to be required

3 under the Help America Vote Act and submit his

4 recommendations in that regard to the joint appropriations

5 interim committee and the joint corporations, elections and

political subdivisions interim committee and the governor. 6

7 Disbursements and expenditures from the account shall be

made by the secretary of state. 8

12 The Wyoming legislature finds and acknowledges (a)

13 its intent in enacting this act as follows:

14

15 The federal funds promised or delivered to (i)

Wyoming under the Help America Vote Act and five percent 16

17 (5%) matching state appropriations are limited to meeting

federal requirements contained in that act including 18

replacement of voting systems in most counties, creation of 19

20 a statewide voter registration system, maintenance of those

21 systems and meeting several other requirements commencing

22 with the 2006 elections and continuing for future federal

23 elections;

24

(ii) Costs of state and federal elections in 1

2 Wyoming are, and have always been statutorily placed on

3 county governments through the office of county clerk.

4 creation of the account under this act seeks to ensure that

5 future additional election costs for Wyoming and Wyoming

counties mandated by the Help America Vote Act will be met 6

7 and will not turn into an unfunded mandate for Wyoming

counties. 8

10 Ten million dollars (\$10,000,000.00) is Section 3.

11 appropriated from the general fund and shall be credited to

12 the account created by this act. To the extent additional

13 federal funds are received to implement the Help America

Vote Act after the effective date of this act, funds 14

appropriated to the account under this section shall be 15

16 returned to the general fund on a dollar per dollar basis

17 per additional federal funds received.

18

19 Section 4. This act is effective immediately upon

20 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

21 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the

22 Constitution.
