A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to revocation of parole; amending who shall
2 serve as the hearing officer in specified revocation of
3 parole hearings; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 7-13-408(b) is amended to read:

9 **7-13-408. Probation, parole and conditional release**
10 **revocation hearing procedures.**

12 (b) Any hearing pursuant to this section may be
13 before the state probation and parole officer, his
14 designated hearing officer or any other person authorized
15 pursuant to the laws of this state to hear cases of alleged

1 probation, parole or conditional release violations, except
2 that no hearing officer shall be the person making the
3 allegation of violation. In cases of alleged parole
4 violations by persons who were paroled by the board,
5 hearings pursuant to this section shall be before the
6 executive director of the board or his designated hearing
7 officer.

8
9 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
10 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
11 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
12 Constitution.
