A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state parks, historical and other sites;
2 providing for deposit of funds received for leases and
3 concessions at state parks, historical and other sites;
4 providing a continuous appropriation of funds; and
5 providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 36-4-110, 36-8-1001(f) and 36-8-303
10 are amended to read:

11

12 **36-4-110. Power to lease or rent concessions.**

13

14 The department, in consultation with the commission, is
15 empowered to lease, enter into contracts regarding ~~or rent~~

1 and assess fees for concessions, cabin sites, boat clubs,
2 and other services of all lawful kinds and nature on state
3 outdoor recreation areas or facilities to persons,
4 partnerships, and corporations for a valuable consideration
5 upon such terms and conditions as the department deems fit
6 and proper. Funds received by the department pursuant to
7 this section shall be deposited and expended in accordance
8 with W.S. 36-4-121(h).

9
10 **36-8-1001. Description and declaration; plan for park**
11 **development and operation; plan for development of prison**
12 **buildings as state historic site.**

13
14 (f) The department of state parks and cultural
15 resources is authorized to enter into leasehold or
16 concession agreements in accordance with the plan provided
17 by subsection (d) of this section. Funds received by the
18 department pursuant to this section shall be deposited and
19 expended in accordance with W.S. 36-4-121(h).

21 **36-8-303. Disposition of moneys received.**

22
23 Except as otherwise provided in this section, any and all
24 moneys which may be received for rentals of said lands or

1 waters, or any portion thereof, or for the use of said
2 water in any form or any portion thereof, and all money in
3 any way derived from said state lands shall be paid into
4 the state treasury as other moneys belonging to the state
5 and shall be credited by the state treasurer to the general
6 fund. Funds received pursuant to W.S. 36-4-110 and 36-8-
7 1001(f) from state outdoor recreation areas or facilities
8 on such lands shall be deposited and expended in accordance
9 with W.S. 36-4-121(h).

10

11 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
12 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
13 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
14 Constitution.
