Task force on capitol facilities.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the administration of government;
 2 creating a joint legislative and executive task force to
 3 address space allocation requirements as specified;
 4 providing appropriations; and providing for an effective
 5 date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.**

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11 (a) There is created the joint legislative and
 12 executive task force on capitol facilities.

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14 (b) The task force shall be comprised of:

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16 (i) The governor or his designee;

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1 (ii) The secretary of state or his designee;

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3 (iii) The state treasurer or her designee;

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5 (iv) The state auditor or his designee;

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7 (v) The state superintendent of public
8 instruction or his designee;

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10 (vi) The president, vice president, majority and
11 minority floor leaders of the Wyoming senate;

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13 (vii) The speaker, speaker pro tempore, majority
14 and minority floor leaders of the Wyoming house of
15 representatives; and

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17 (viii) The two (2) legislative liaisons to the
18 state building commission and the chairman of the
19 appropriations committee of the house of representatives.

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21 (c) The senate president shall serve as chairman of
22 the task force.

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24 (d) The task force shall:

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2 (i) Conduct a comprehensive review of space
3 requirements of the state-wide elected officials and the
4 legislature;

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6 (ii) Review previous reports and studies and
7 consider space allocation alternatives including the
8 possible relocation of offices and the lease, purchase or
9 construction of additional facilities;

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11 (iii) Develop maintenance, repair and
12 restoration priorities for the state capitol and existing
13 facilities within the capitol complex;

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15 (iv) Develop both long and short term proposals
16 for addressing space requirements both in the state capitol
17 building and in the capitol complex;

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19 (v) Periodically report their findings and
20 recommendations to the state building commission, the
21 legislative management council and the joint appropriations
22 interim committee;

1 (vi) Submit specific project recommendations to
2 the state building commission for approval and
3 authorization of funding; and

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5 (vii) Recommend to the management council
6 statutory changes that may be required to implement project
7 recommendations.

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9 (e) Staff support for the task force shall be
10 provided by the legislative service office and by any state
11 agency upon request.

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13 **Section 2.**

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15 (a) Forty thousand dollars (\$40,000.00) is
16 appropriated from the general fund to the legislative
17 service office to fund the interim meetings and activities
18 of the task force and to contract with appropriate
19 professionals as necessary to complete the task force
20 study. Expenditure of funds under this subsection shall be
21 subject to management council approval.

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23 (b) Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000.00)
24 is appropriated from the general fund to the state building

1 commission to be used to implement projects recommended by
2 the task force and approved by the commission.

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4 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
5 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
6 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
7 Constitution.
