A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming
Constitution to authorize the legislature to distribute to
the citizens of Wyoming surplus tax monies.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING, 6 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting 7 separately, concurring therein:

9 Section 1. The following proposal to amend Wyoming 10 Constitution, Article 16, Section 6 is proposed for 11 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the 12 next general election for approval or rejection to become 13 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a 14 majority of the electors at the election:

Article 16, Section 6. Loan of credit; donations
prohibited; works of internal improvement; distribution to
citizens.

Neither the state nor any county, city, township, town, 5 6 school district, or any other political subdivision, shall 7 loan or give its credit or make donations to or in aid of 8 any individual, association or corporation, except for 9 necessary support of the poor or as otherwise provided in 10 this section, nor subscribe to or become the owner of the 11 capital stock of any association or corporation, except that funds of public employee retirement systems and the 12 13 permanent funds of the state of Wyoming may be invested in 14 such stock under conditions the legislature prescribes. The 15 state shall not engage in any work of internal improvement 16 unless authorized by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the people. 17 The legislature may distribute to the citizens of this 18 state, on a per capita basis, tax monies in excess of the amount necessary to support the current operations of 19 20 government, as defined by the legislature, or required by 21 law to be held in trust by the state.
