A JOINT RESOLUTION relating to taxation and revenue; making residential property an additional class of property for assessment of taxes; granting the legislature the ability to determine for residential property the total ad valorem tax, restrict increases in property taxes or assessments, create subclasses and set assessment rates on subclasses.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING, 9 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting 10 separately, concurring therein:

Section 1. The following proposal to amend Wyoming Constitution, Article 15, Section 11(a), (c), (d) and by creating a new subsection (e) is proposed for submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the next general election for approval or rejection, to become valid as a
