- 15 (a) Services and supplies authorized for medical
- 16 assistance under this chapter include:

2 (xxix) Human organ and tissue transplant

5 (c) Payments to qualified hospitals pursuant to paragraphs (a)(i) and (ii) of this section shall be made 6 7 using a prospective payment methodology that produces a rate approximately equivalent to one hundred percent (100%) 8 9 of the actual allowable cost for equivalent services, as 10 adjusted annually by the department. For purposes of this 11 subsection, a hospital is a qualified hospital if it is 12 certified by the department pursuant to its rules and 13 regulations as having or being in the process of developing 14 an effective patient care improvement program or quality 15 staff retention program.
