A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; providing for the use of  
2 fog lamps as specified; and providing for an effective  
3 date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-5-910 is amended to read:

9 **31-5-910. Lighted lamps and illuminating devices.**

11 Every vehicle including those listed in W.S. 31-5-901(c),  
12 except as otherwise provided in this act, upon a highway  
13 within this state at any time from one-half (1/2) hour  
14 after sunset to one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise and at  
15 any other time when, due to insufficient light or  
16 unfavorable atmospheric conditions, persons and vehicles on  
17 the highway are not clearly discernible at a distance of

1 one thousand (1,000) feet ahead shall display lighted head  
2 and other lamps and illuminating devices as respectively  
3 required for different classes of vehicles, subject to  
4 exceptions with respect to parked vehicles. Fog lamps shall  
5 only be used in the same manner as head lamps as provided  
6 in this section, and during periods of inclement weather  
7 including snow, rain or fog according to rules and  
8 regulations of the department. Stop lights, turn signals  
9 and other signaling devices shall be lighted as prescribed  
10 for those devices.

12 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2004.
