1 (a) The federal bureau of land management lands

2 currently under recreation and public purposes lease

3 W-81044 to Lincoln county and described as follows are

4 designated as the Hams Fork state park: In Township 21

5 North, Range 116 West, 6th P.M., Section 1, Lots 15, 17, 18,

6 19 and 20, containing 101.56 acres more or less.

7

8 (b) Nothing in this section terminates any lease,

9 reservation or right-of-way on the lands described in this

10 section, existing as of January 1, 2004.

11

12 (c) The Lincoln county board of commissioners shall

13 notify the federal bureau of land management of the board's

14 willingness to transfer or assign the lease described in

15 subsection (a) of this section on the lands to the Wyoming

16 department of state parks and cultural resources not later

17 than June 30, 2004.

19 (d) The Wyoming parks and cultural resources

20 commission shall prepare a plan for the development and

21 operation of the Hams Fork state park. The plan shall be

22 presented to the joint travel, recreation, wildlife and

23 cultural resources interim committee no later than the

1 second Tuesday in January, 2005. In developing the plan,

2 the commission shall:

4 (i) Consider the plan for the area which was

5 developed by the national park service, long distance

6 trails office of Salt Lake City, Utah, in cooperation with

7 the Kemmerer-Diamondville chamber of commerce, city of

8 Kemmerer, county of Lincoln and members of the public;

9

10 (ii) Evaluate the possibility of park

11 development and administration by the city of Kemmerer or

12 the county of Lincoln;

13

14 (iii) Consult with the city of Kemmerer, county

15 of Lincoln and have the full cooperation of the Wyoming

16 department of transportation in planning access and

17 directional signs to the park;

18

19 (iv) Amend the plan of development for the lease

20 specified in subsection (a) of this section with the

21 federal bureau of land management, if necessary.

23 (e) The department of state parks and cultural

24 resources and the Wyoming parks and cultural resources

1 commission shall administer and operate the state park

2 created by this section in accordance with the plan

3 developed under subsection (d) of this section, unless

4 otherwise directed by the legislature.
