2	provisions pertaining to the investigation of communicable
3	diseases and quarantine by the state and county health
4	officers; and providing for an effective date.
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6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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8	Section 1. W.S. 35-4-103 is amended to read:
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10	35-4-103. Investigation of diseases; quarantine;
11	regulation of travel; employment of police officers to
12	enforce quarantine; report of county health officer;
13	supplies and expenses.
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15	It shall be the duty of The department of health shall,
16	immediately after the receipt of the information that there

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1 is any smallpox, cholera, scarlet fever, diphtheria or 2 other infectious or contagious disease, which is a menace 3 to the public health, in any portion of this state, to 4 order the county health officer by telegram or telephone, 5 if he is not at hand to proceed immediately to said case and there to immediately investigate said the case or 6 7 cases, and to report to the state health officer, by telephone or telegram, the results of 8 <del>said the</del> 9 investigation., and it shall be the duty of The state 10 health officer, shall subject to W.S. 35-4-112 and if in 11 his judgment the occasion requires, to-direct the county 12 health officer to declare said the infected place to be in 13 quarantine and to place any and all restrictions upon the 14 ingress and egress thereat at this location as in his judgment<sub> $\tau$ </sub> or in the judgment of the state health officer 15 16 shall be is necessary to prevent the spread of the disease 17 from the infected locality.; and it shall be the duty of The said county health officer when he shall have declared 18 19 shall upon declaring any city, or town or other place to be 20 in quarantine, so to control and dispose of the population 21 of said the city, town or other place, and make such 22 disposition of the same, as shall in his judgment best 23 protect protects the people and at the same time prevent 24 prevents the spread of the disease. among the same. 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1 when deemed If necessary for the protection of the public health and subject to W.S. 35-4-112, the state health 2 3 officer shall establish and maintain a state quarantine $\tau$ 4 and shall enforce such practical regulations regarding 5 railroads, stage lines, or other lines of travel into and out of the state of Wyoming as they so deem proper and 6 7 necessary for the protection of the public health., and The expenses incurred in maintaining said the state quarantine 8 9 shall be paid out of the funds of the state treasury 10 appropriated for this purpose and in the manner in which 11 other expenses of the department are audited and paid. The 12 county health officer, or the department, are hereby 13 authorized to may employ a sufficient number of police officers who shall be under the control of the county 14 health officer, to enforce and carry out any and all 15 quarantine regulations the department may prescribe., which 16 17 said The regulations shall be made public in the most practicable manner, in the several counties, cities, towns 18 19 or other places where the quarantine may be is established. 20 And where If the quarantine is established by the county 21 health officer, he shall make immediate immediately report 22 of his actions and doings in the premises to the state 23 health officer. and from time to time so long as quarantine 24 shall continue. It shall also be the duty of The county

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health officer to shall furnish all supplies, in the nature 1 2 of clothing, provisions, construction of pesthouses or 3 other things necessary for the maintaining of such the 4 5 officer $_{\tau}$  approved by the director of the state department 6 of health, it shall be the duty of the county commissioners of any county where  $\frac{such}{a}$  quarantine has been established, 7 to shall issue warrant or warrants to the proper parties 8 9 for the payment of all expenses, together with the expense 10 of employing sufficient police force, to maintain and 11 enforce said the quarantine. For purposes of this act, "state health officer" means as defined in W.S. 9-2-101(f)12 13 9-2-103(e). 14
