Driver's licenses-selective service.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; providing that qualified
2 applicants be registered with the selective service system
3 in order to receive a driver's license or an identification
4 card; providing that qualified applicants not registered be
5 ineligible to receive a license or identification card; and
6 providing for an effective date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-7-108(b) by creating a new
11 paragraph (viii), 31-7-111 by creating new subsections (g)
12 through (m), 31-7-119(b), 31-8-101 by creating new
13 subsections (c) through (g) and 31-8-103 by creating a new
14 subsection (d) are amended to read:

15

1 **31-7-108. Persons not to be licensed; investigation**
2 **by the division.**

3

4 (b) The division shall not issue or renew any
5 driver's license to any person:

6

7 (viii) Who is not in compliance with W.S.
8 31-7-111(g) through (m).

9

10 **31-7-111. Application for license or commercial**
11 **driver's license or permit generally.**

12

13 (g) Qualified applicants for a motor vehicle driver's
14 license pursuant to this section or an instruction and
15 temporary permit shall be registered with the United States
16 selective service system in compliance with title 50 U.S.C.
17 appendix § 453, as amended.

18

19 (h) Every qualified applicant identified in
20 subsection (g) of this section shall be required to
21 authorize the division to:

22

1 (i) Collect the necessary personal information
2 required for registering the qualified applicant with the
3 United States selective service system; and

4
5 (ii) Electronically transmit the information on
6 the application to the selective service system pursuant to
7 subsection (k) of this section for purposes of registering
8 the qualified applicant with the selective service system.

9
10 (j) The division shall notify all qualified
11 applicants identified in subsection (g) of this section
12 that by submitting an application, the qualified applicant
13 is consenting to registration with the selective service
14 system, if so required by federal law.

15
16 (k) The division shall collect from a qualified
17 applicant the necessary personal information required for
18 registering the qualified applicant with the United States
19 selective service system. The division shall transmit the
20 necessary personal information of the qualified applicant
21 in an electronic format to the selective service system to
22 register the qualified applicant.

23

1 (m) For purposes of this section, "qualified
2 applicant" means male United States citizens and male
3 immigrants at least eighteen (18) years of age but less
4 than twenty-six (26) years of age.

6 **31-7-119. Expiration and renewal; required tests;**
7 **extension.**

8
9 (b) The division shall require every person applying
10 for renewal of a driver's license to take and successfully
11 pass a test of his eyesight. Qualified applicants, as
12 defined in W.S. 31-7-111(m), renewing a driver's license
13 shall be subject to the provisions of W.S. 31-7-111(g)
14 through (k). The division may require any applicant to
15 take and successfully pass any additional tests or provide
16 affidavits required or authorized under the original
17 application as the division finds reasonably necessary to
18 determine his qualification according to the type or class
19 of license. The written test for a hazardous materials
20 endorsement shall be taken and passed if the person wants
21 to retain an "H" endorsement.

23 **31-8-101. Issuance to residents by department;**
24 **restrictions.**

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2 (c) Qualified applicants for an identification card
3 shall be registered with the United States selective
4 service system in compliance with title 50 U.S.C. appendix
5 § 453, as amended.

6

7 (d) Every qualified applicant identified in
8 subsection (g) of this section shall be required to
9 authorize the department of transportation to:

10

11 (i) Collect the necessary personal information
12 required for registering the qualified applicant with the
13 United States selective service system; and

14

15 (ii) Electronically transmit the information to
16 the selective service system pursuant to subsection (f) of
17 this section for purposes of registering the qualified
18 applicant with the selective service system.

19

20 (e) The department of transportation shall notify all
21 qualified applicants identified in subsection (c) of this
22 section that by submitting an application, the qualified is
23 consenting to registration with the selective service
24 system, if so required by federal law.

1

2 (f) The department of transportation shall collect
3 from a qualified applicant the necessary personal
4 information required for registering the qualified
5 applicant with the United States selective service system.
6 The department of transportation shall transmit the
7 necessary personal information of the qualified applicant
8 in an electronic format to the selective service system to
9 register the qualified applicant.

10

11 (g) For purposes of this section, "qualified
12 applicant" means male United States citizens and male
13 immigrants at least eighteen (18) years of age but less
14 than twenty-six (26) years of age.

15

16 **31-8-103. Expiration; records; new cards.**

17

18 (d) The department of transportation shall not issue
19 an identification card under this section to a qualified
20 applicant, as defined by W.S. 31-8-101(g), unless the
21 applicant complies with W.S. 31-8-101(c) through (g).

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Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2004.
